Adult Education is the process of helping adults build on existing knowledge while continuing to learn in a purposeful way. This takes place in varied settings and organizations.

Human Resource Development is a set of activities designed by an organization to provide its members with opportunities to learn necessary skills to meet current and future job demands. It is aimed at improving performance and productivity within the organization.
