Dr. Webb will explore quasars, supermassive black holes and exotic objects at the edge of the Universe. He will play music composed from quasar observations. Dr. Webb earned his PhD in astronomy from the University of Florida. His research focuses on active galaxies and Blazars. He has been the director of the SARA Observatory located at Kitt Peak for the past 15 years. He has won several teaching awards including the "Presidential teaching awards". He plays guitar and writes astronomy music.



Acclaimed composer/producer Jonn Serrie is at the electronic music forefront with hundreds of concerts worldwide and musical scores including PBS "John Glenn an American Hero", Discovery Channel "Wings" series and "What The Bleep Do We Know?" movie. He is also a search and rescue pilot for the U.S. Air Force Auxilliary.
