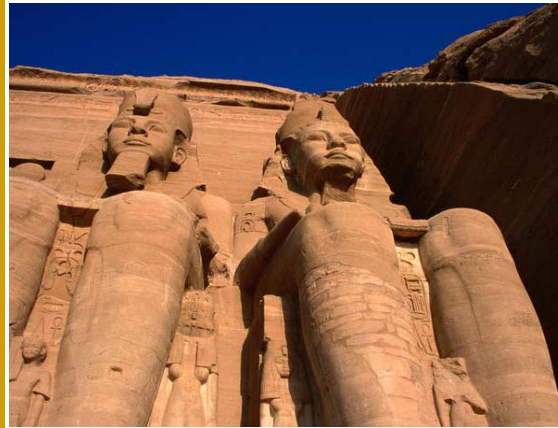
## Refereeing Policy and Proceedings
