### **Student Representative Application**

*Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution*

Thank you for your interest in serving as a student representative on the University Student Conduct Committee! The University Student Conduct Committee is comprised of one faculty or staff member, two student representatives and a Student Conduct Administrator. This hearing body is one of the formal resolution options utilized in the University Student Conduct system. The University Student Conduct Committee provides students an opportunity to be heard by fellow community members in situations where they have been charged with violations of the Student Code of Conduct.

You hear the case, review the evidence, and decide the hearing outcome. We need **YOU** to serve in this capacity. Currently, we are accepting applications for the 2010-2011 board.

**The responsibilities of a Student Conduct Committee hearing member include:**

- Attendance at training sessions
- Awareness of the Student Code of Conduct and student conduct procedures
- Participation in at least one scheduled hearing per month (usually a 2-4 hour commitment)

**To be considered students must:**

- Be in good academic and good student conduct standing with the University
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Submit an application
- Participate in an interview with SCCR staff members
- Attend two mandatory training sessions (these are tentatively scheduled for October 1, 2010 and October 8, 2010)

If you are interested in serving on the University Student Conduct Committee please complete the enclosed application and **return it to the Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution in the Graham Center 311.** You may also email your application to [ktravies@fiu.edu](mailto:ktravies@fiu.edu). Selected students will be contacted regarding interviews and training sessions. **You applications are due no later than September 17, 2010 by 4 pm.**

**Please complete the following scenarios. If you wish, you may refer to FIU policies and sanction that are outlined in the Student Code of Conduct, in the 2010-2011 FIU Student Handbook. The handbook is available online at <http://www.fiu.edu/~sccr/>**

1. A student is found in her room with a strong odor of marijuana in the air. There is a towel stuffed under the door, a window is open, all of the vents are closed and there is incense burning in the room. The RA's confiscate an ashtray full of warm ashes and a marijuana pipe. What are some of the issues to be considered? Do you think that student should be found responsible of violating FIU's drug policy? If so, what would be a fair sanction for the student?

2. A student is accused of having alcohol in his room and is found responsible by the Student Conduct Committee. After the student is found responsible, the Student Conduct Committee has to determine an appropriate sanction. During the sanctioning phase of the hearing, the Student Conduct Committee members find out that the student has been found guilty of the same offense twice before. What type of sanctions should the Student Conduct Committee give in this situation?

3. How do you feel about making decisions regarding another peer's conduct and when appropriate, applying behavioral sanctions to him/her?
