Write an introductory paragraph presenting the scientific advance you discussed last week as though you were applying for a grant to explore this idea for the first time:

Do it twice – once well, once badly:

1. Present it in a way that would be appealing to the reviewers of grants for a federal funding agency (specify which: NSF, NIH, USDA).
2. Present it in a way that would flop with a funding agency.

Doing it well is much harder than doing it badly.

You will find good instruction on writing the “Introductory Paragraph” in *The Grant Application Writer’s Workbook* (~pp 43-44).
